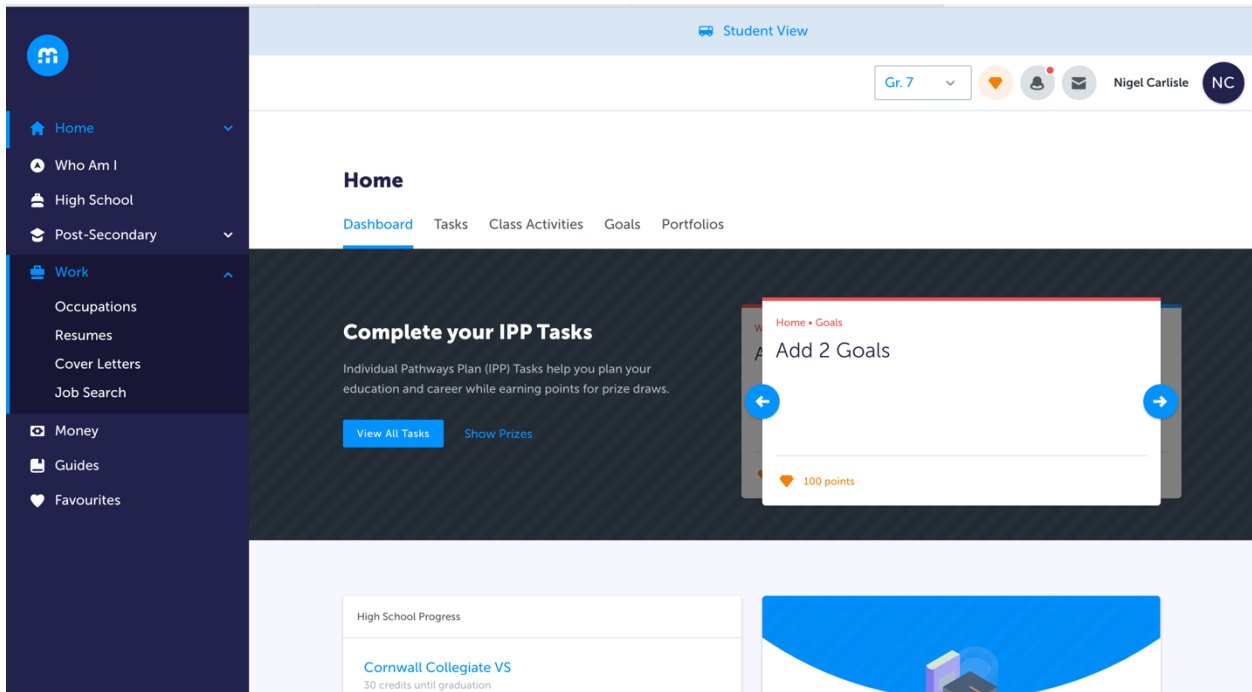

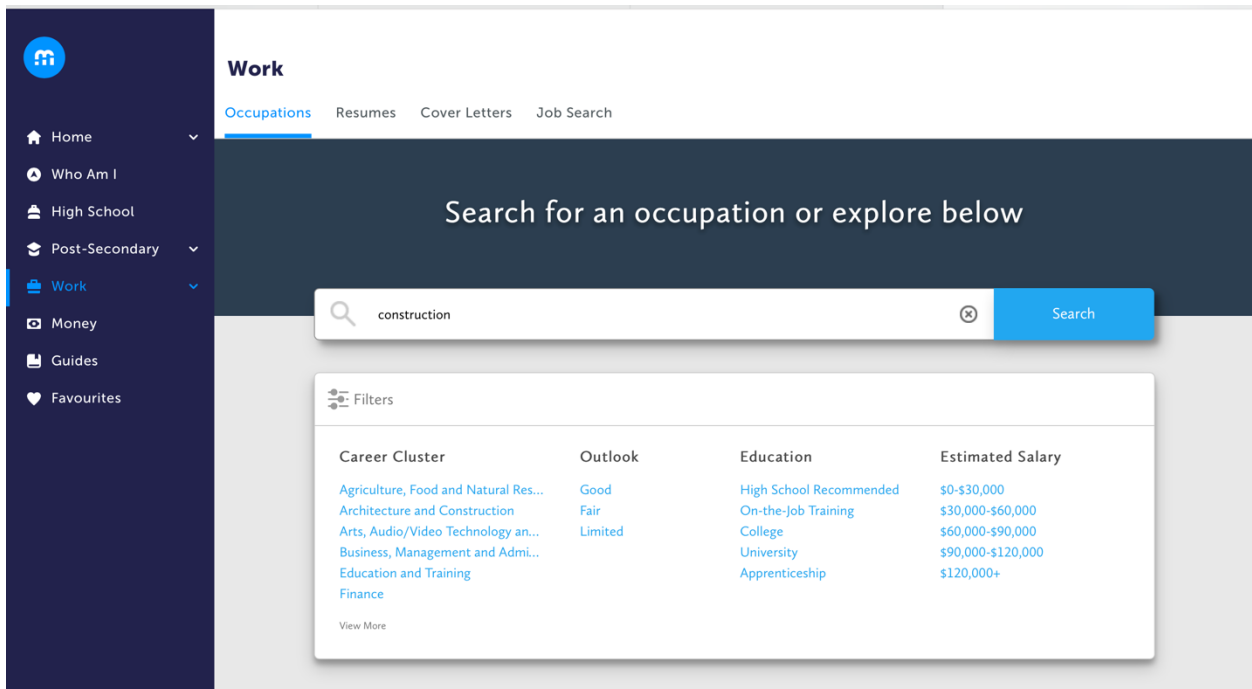
2. Click on " Work" located on left hand menu.
